Overview:

The NRA Home Firearm Safety training is the basic course recommended to anyone unfamiliar with guns, needs to learn gun terminology, or learn handling basic firearm types.

Course Goal:

To teach basic knowledge and skills, and to explain the attitude necessary for the safe handling and storage of guns in the home.

NRA Home Firearm Safety Course Lesson Plan:

In the four hour course students will learn rules of safe gun handling, identifying and unloading various firearms, ammunition, cleaning and storage, and will get hands-on experience with the most common types of handguns, rifles, and shotguns. A representation of each type of common firearm will be provided.

Lessons:

1. The Elements of Gun Safety
2. Identifying and Unloading Different Firearms
3. Types of Ammunition
4. Cleaning and Storage of Firearms
5. Practical Exercise in Safe Gun Handling

Prerequisites:

There are no prerequisites for taking this course. Anyone under 16 must have an adult with them to handle firearms.
