Dear Cascade Properties Member,

Welcome to CSF! This letter is to introduce you to the new Cascade Shooting Facilities (CSF). CSF is a Washington State non profit corporation, formed in agreement with King County, Cascade Rifle and Pistol Properties and Cascade Rifle and Pistol Club, to be the Cascade Range leaseholder at the King County Shooting Sports Park. By virtue of being a holder of a Cascade Rifle and Pistol Properties certificate of membership, you are eligible to become a “Properties” member in CSF. The “Properties” membership will afford you access to all CSF amenities. These include the outdoor range, the Clubhouse and indoor range.

The Properties membership in CSF will be dues free for the duration of the life of the individual member listed on January 1st, 2010. It will not be transferrable to any other person, party or trust. As a CSF Properties member, you will enjoy all of the rights, privileges and responsibilities of any member in good standing, but without the burden of annual dues.

Cascade R&P Properties will forward a final membership list to CSF on January 1st, 2010. This will be the list of those eligible for Properties membership in CSF. CSF will issue a key to the one individual listed on the membership. In the event that person is a minor, a key will be issued to the parent or legal adult guardian. A second key will be issued to a spouse for \$10. If you meet the description above of eligibility, you may obtain your key by attending and completing any regular New Member Orientation. This orientation also requires that each attendee read and sign an acknowledgement for the “target letter”, a policy statement regarding proper target placement and terms for non compliance. At the completion of the orientation, you will be issued keys and an identification badge. Orientations are held on the Saturday following the General Meeting. You can find the exact dates and a step by step process for enrollment by going to our website at http://www.cascadeshootingfacilities.org/application_process.pdf.

We also want you to know that the structure of the CSF bylaws provides for supermajority vote protection of the Properties membership, and of the Board positions formed to assure proportional Properties’ representation on the Board. Additionally, as a result of the bylaws language and structure, beginning immediately, you are eligible for nomination to the position of Public Use Director, or Range Maintenance Director positions on the Board of Directors of CSF. These positions are new, and currently vacant. As stated in the bylaws:

Section 8. Maintenance Director - shall be a holder of Certificate of Membership of Cascade Rifle and Pistol Properties Corporation. The Maintenance Director shall be responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of both the indoor and outdoor ranges and all associated facilities. The Maintenance Director shall contract no bills without the authorization of the Board of Directors.

Section 9. Public Use Director shall be a holder of Certificate of Membership of Cascade Rifle and Pistol Properties Corporation. The Public Use Director shall coordinate the staffing of public shooting, by insuring that sufficient volunteer labor is available to cover the event, coordinate and communicate with the Board of Directors to insure that all Club rules and policies are being followed, that the Board's instructions are being followed, and that the public shooting sessions are being conducted in an efficient and businesslike manner. The Public Use Director shall contract no bills without the authorization of the Board of Directors

You can also offer your name or a nomination at the January 2010 general meeting. A list of the nominees will be collated at the January meeting of the Board of Directors. This list and a ballot will be sent to all of the membership for a vote. Ballots will be counted at the February 2010 general meeting. As with the other 7 positions, these two positions will be interim positions only. All Board positions will be up for election in April, 2010 for a one year term.
